Only test scores earned within two years preceding the submission date of the applicant's current application will be acceptable. IELTS overall scores of 6.5 meet the minimum English language requirements, while TOEFL must have a minimum score of 575 (for paper based) and 90 (for internet based). Filipino students will be assessed on the basis of their submitted written work, along with a verifiable certification that it is their own work and have not received substantial editing (which means that parts have to rewritten by another person).

Ideally, the writing sample should be a recent paper or book, or chapter/s in a Master's thesis, or a major paper, reflecting current writing ability and interests. Projects written ten to fifteen years ago will not be as helpful in the application evaluation process.

The sample will be evaluated on the quality and clarity of your argumentation, your ability to communicate concepts in English, and how appropriately you work with scholarly sources. In addition, it must have appropriate citations throughout (in-text citations with a works-cited section, footnotes, or endnotes are all acceptable).
